- Couples must present valid government issued photo identification at their appointment.
- Payment options include cash, credit/debit card, check, cashier's check, and/or money order, payable to the Orange County Clerk-Recorder.

Another reason to join us, the department has one of the lowest costs for a marriage license and a marriage ceremony in the state. In Orange County, couples can obtain a public marriage license for \$61 and a confidential marriage license for \$66. A civil marriage ceremony can be performed for an additional \$28.



JANUARY IN O.C. HISTORY

"Orange County" was first suggested as a possible name for a new county at a meeting in Gallatin (now part of Downey). At that point, there were no commercial orange groves in the area.

Jan. 11, 1962 The City of Villa Park incorporated.

Jan. 23, 1890 Cordelia Knott was born. The restaurant she started in the 1930s would be the first step in making the Knott family's berry farm a major California landmark.

Jan. 25, 1980 Groundbreaking ceremonies were held for the Orange County Marine Institute at Dana Point.

Jan. 26, 1886 The Santa Ana, Orange & Tustin Street Railway Co. was formed. This was Orange County's first horsecar trolly line.


