

JULY IN O.C. HISTORY

July 8, 1965

The Festival of Arts (seen here in the 1940s) began in 1932 and has become an Orange County summer tradition. "Living pictures" debuted there in 1933, becoming "The Pageant of the Masters" in 1935. The pageant moved into the new Irvine Bowl in 1941.

July 18, 1955	Disneyland opened to the public for the first time. A special televised event for the press and VIPs was held at the park the previous day.
	The current concrete pier at Huntington Beach was dedicated. It was the third pier at

that location.

July 19, 1990 Nixon Library & Birthplace in Yorba Linda, which opened to the public the following day.

July 29, 1936 The Laguna Beach Festival of the Arts and Pageant of the Masters proudly debuted a new technological marvel: Its first public address system.
